**Statement on Waseca High School Girls and Boys Basketball based on the Minnesota State High School League (MSHSL) Postseason Tournament Play and COVID-19.**

The MSHSL, relying on information from the Minnesota Department of Health, announced today that the number of people allowed to attend all remaining State and Section playoff games will now be limited.

According to the new policy effective tomorrow, “attendance at tournaments is now limited to rostered participants, coaches, event staff, TV network partners, credentialed media, and a small number of school-approved spectators of each participating team.”

Because this situation is rapidly changing, plans for events to be held after this weekend are being developed and will be communicated at a later date.

We are awaiting information from the MSHSL regarding who is allowed to be a part of our “small number of school-approved spectators.” Once we receive that information, we plan on working with both our Girls and Boys Basketball teams to develop that list. If you are eligible to attend an event, you will be required to provide photo identification and will have to purchase a ticket.

Waseca High School is blessed to have amazing student and community support for its cocurricular activities. Fans are encouraged to follow all remaining Girls and Boys Basketball games via broadcast, streaming, or social media. Fans can watch the Girls Basketball game live on Channel 45TV and [45tv.com/prep45](http://45tv.com/prep45). The game will also be broadcast on AM 1170, 106.3 FM, and <http://theradiotrain.com/>.
