After a 40 year career in education, Waseca Schools Superintendent has decided to retire. The School Board accepted his letter of retirement at their regular meeting on January 23, 2020. On Thursday, February 6th, the Board reviewed proposals from three executive search consultants and decided that Harold Remme and Ed Waltman from South Central Service Cooperative would lead the search.

The first step in the search process will be to develop a profile of the next leader. To do so, the consultants will hold meetings with individual Board members and staff. **The community is invited to a Community Input Meeting next Tuesday, February 18th at 6:30 in the School Board Room (2nd floor Central Building).**

Interviews of candidates will occur the week of March 16th. Finalist interviews, including a community interview, will occur the week of March 23rd. You can find more specific information on the District website.
