eLearning Day Plan

STUDENT/PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. If a student is sick or needs to be absent for another reason on an eLearning Day, parents still need to call the school office. Please leave a message if necessary.
2. Parents should review and be familiar with the following expectations and procedures. Please check in with your student(s) to be sure they understand what they need to do and are able to connect with their teacher(s) if needed.
3. Students will meet (Google Meet- invite in their email) with their homeroom teacher to organize their day (most likely 9 AM, but this time will be communicated with the students). eLearning content will be delivered asynchronously.
4. Students will have assignments in Math, Reading, and their current PFAME (P.E., Music, Art, or Media) class.
5. Students are responsible for completing all work as assigned by their teachers.
6. Assignments will be created for students to be able to complete within a maximum of 40 minutes **per math and reading class and 20 minutes for their two PFAME classes**. Students will be finished when they complete the tasks for reading/math. They should be able to complete their work within two hours.
7. **It is in your best interest to complete assigned eLearning Day on that day.** However, there can be situations where that would be difficult. With that in mind, assigned work is due after the return to three full days of in-person learning. An additional day will be added for each consecutive eLearning Day.
 - For example, if the eLearning Day is January 19, 2022, then student work is due on January 25, 2022.
 - If there are two eLearning Days in a row, January 19-20, 2022, then student work is due January 27, 2022.
