

Dear Families,

Assuming mandatory Child Care for Emergency workers ends on June 3, 2020 for the Waseca School District, here are details regarding Summer 2020 Jay's Nest Child Care.

Weekdays from 6:30am – 6:00pm beginning Monday, June 8 and ending Thursday, September 3 (Closed Friday, July 3) for 63 days of operation, we will set up age specific classrooms with a maximum of nine students. **Those who sign up for child care will be committing to pay for all 63 days of care at \$30/day, whether the child is in attendance or not.**

Registration includes a \$25 registration fee and will be on-line with first come, first serve beginning at 8:00am on Monday, May 18. Registration will be through the Eleyo registration program and can be found at <https://waseca.ce.eleyo.com>, or through the Community Education tab on the Waseca Public Schools' website at www.waseca.k12.mn.us If an age/grade level fills up and enough students are on a waiting list for that age/grade, we will make every effort to open up another section of that age/grade level. **Following registration and before attendance can begin, the Jay's Nest registration materials must be filled out.** Once a child is registered, parents will be contacted regarding how/when to obtain and fill out the materials.

Parents must agree to an automatic withdrawal payment plan with a credit card, or pay for the entire summer with a one-time credit card payment. Parents on county assistance will work with the community education business office for payments, with the CE business office working with the county to ensure payments.

These rooms will run independently of the other rooms and we will limit the number of students in common spaces such as the gyms, playgrounds, etc. In the cafeteria we will again limit the number and have them spaced according to social distancing guidelines. At the end of the day, each room will be sanitized. Staff will be offered masks and gloves to wear.

Access to the Central Building will be limited to one entrance, door 8 on the NorthWest corner of the building. **Students will have their temperature taken, as well as washing their hands, prior to entering the facility.** Parents/guardians will not be allowed past the check-in station. Any student having a temperature of 100 degrees or higher will not be allowed into the building. If a student develops a temperature of 100 degrees or higher during the day, they will need to be picked up within 30 minutes. For pick-up, parents/guardians will again use the single entrance and not be allowed past the check-in station as children will be escorted down to the pick-up.
