

We have received new guidance from the state regarding summer child care, and as such, the registration process for summer 2020 Jay's Nest is being adjusted accordingly.

On Monday, May 18 (beginning at 8:00am) and Tuesday, May 19, only parents who are Tier I workers will be allowed to register for summer Jay's Nest. Any non-Tier I registrations made during this time will be removed.

On Wednesday, May 20 and Thursday, May 21 only parents who are Tier II workers will be allowed to register for summer Jay's Nest. Any non-Tier II registrations made during this time will be removed.

On Friday, May 22 only parents who are Tier III workers will be allowed to register for summer Jay's Nest. Any non-Tier III registrations made during this time will be removed.

Beginning Saturday, May 23, summer Jay's Nest will be opened up to anyone, providing there is room left in the program.

Proof of employment in one of the Tier categories will be required. A list of occupations under each of the three Tiers is listed below. We ask that you respect this process as we are following state guidelines. We understand this is a difficult time for parents, and we apologize for any inconvenience. Thank you for your understanding.

· Energy · Water and Wastewater · Transportation and logistics · Public works and infrastructure support services · Communications and information technology · Other community-based government operations and essential functions · Critical manufacturing · Hazardous materials · Financial services · Chemical · Defense industrial base · Charitable and social services organizations · Residential/shelter facilities and services · State workers essential to the continuation of Minnesota Unemployment Insurance

· Tribal Governments · Executive Branch (priority services), including state workers essential to the continuation of Minnesota Unemployment Insurance · Executive Constitutional Offices (essential personnel) · Legislative Branch (essential services) ·
