



HIGH SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

Advanced Algebra 2:

-Students will need a 3-ring binder and loose-leaf paper (college rule) used specifically for math class. It will be left in class some days. A 1" or 1.5" is recommended.

A Texas Instrument Graphing calculator is also required (TI-83 or TI-84 models including PLUS and CE are acceptable). They are usually on sale in August. If you are unsure you have the correct type, have your student bring in the unopened package and I can check it. You can also email questions to nelb@waseca.k12.mn.us. There are a limited number available at the high school to rent for \$20 per year.

Algebra 2:

-A graphing calculator is highly recommended but not required. TI-83 or TI-84 models including PLUS and CE are acceptable. They are usually on sale in August. If you are unsure you have the correct type, have your student bring in the unopened package and I can check it. You can also email questions to nelb@waseca.k12.mn.us. There are a limited number available at the high school to rent for \$20 per year. If you do not want to invest in a graphing calculator, they will need a basic calculator each day in class (TI-30x is a nice option for around \$13).

AP Calculus:

-Students will need a 3-ring binder that can be used exclusively for math class. A 1.5" or 2" binder is recommended. Students must have a graphing calculator. It is highly recommended that students have a graphing calculator with math print (Most TI-84 models have math print) since half the AP Exam requires a graphing calculator. If students do not have a calculator with math print, there are a limited number available at the high school to rent for \$20. You can email any questions to conwj@waseca.k12.mn.us.
